

St. Ann's Parish Council Notes November 10, 2015

- I. Msgr. Addressed being Catholic today and being “ministers” of the Pastoral letters as well as establishing our identity as a family of faith. We reflected on faith in action and being a doer. A missionary is applicable wherever we are; it is universal.

Future Synod reflections will be coming December 8, 2015 on the family and tribunal practices to help people in second and third marriages.

- II. Next step responses: 81 to date. The goal is to reach at least 75-100 parishioners.
- III. Facility Update: 3 groups have expressed interest: 1 private, 1 Montessori and 1 Charter (more in line with where the Parish aims to be). A target price of \$26 per sq. ft. was discussed for a lease. Depending on final approval, such an arrangement could total \$593 K from revenues to be generated. Possible word by Christmas.
- IV. The cross on the church was removed and repaired after it was struck by lightning. The cost was \$93,000 to replace and restore, covered by insurance.
- v. Starting December 31, 2015 the parish will discontinue 7:00 am mass daily. Noon mass stands as is. Changes made as a reduction in attendance.
